

# A Spectators Guide to a Safe and Enjoyable DSA Swimming Champs Meet

## Do's

- Cheer for your swimmers
- Follow the directions of the meet marshals. They are there to ensure a safe environment for all.
- Support the host team with purchases from our vendors
- Keep little one's under control in the team room.
- Treat the facility with respect, we are guests here. Clean up after yourself.
- Respect the directional signage for parking and swimmer movement in the facility
- Allow seats in the viewing area for spectators whose child is swimming in a current event. When your child is done, please give up your seat to another spectator.

## Don'ts

- Block fire exits, elevators or stairs
- Use foul language
- Approach any official to discuss your child's race. Please do so through your coach.
- Leave trash in the team room.
- Take food into the natatorium stands.
- Sit or stand on the stairs. Yep, we are saying it twice to make sure you know how serious it is to our safety.
- Go on deck unless you have the appropriate credentials (Coach, official, timer, etc)
- Go in the locker rooms. They are for swimmers and meet personnel.
