UPDATE

5/22/20 The DSA Board is following the lead from USA Swimming and the YMCA's decision to cancel the 2020 summer season. We cannot ensure the safety of the coaches, swimmers and parents in the practices and meets for both home and especially traveling away teams. There may be some teams who have an open pool who choose to practice and if those teams want to compete will have to arrange their own meets apart from the DSA League.

We would like to continue the tradition of awarding of scholarships to our league graduating seniors. It will be a reduced number of awarded scholarships as we will not have any 2020 income from dues and Champ fees. Please follow the guidelines on the web under Scholarships to apply with the exceptions below:

- The deadline is extended to July 19 at 8pm EST.
- We are waiving the 4th year of swimming as the season was cancelled.
- We are waiving the required transcripts as we realize that you may not be able to get transcripts since the schools are closed. If you have them then please include.
- You must include both letters of recommendation from a teacher and coach
- Your required essay on how swimming has impacted your personal development, as well as how you plan to continue with participation in swimming after graduation (collegiate, club swimming, master's program, coaching, officiating, swim lessons, lifeguard, ect.) must be included.
- You must submit your application and all documents as (ONE) PDF document. Follow the directions on the web for where to send it.

We would also like to continue the Senior Bio program. Please send us your bios and if you want to include one picture you may. We will post the bios on our web site as we will not be able to read them at champs. Send to ankmm2323@comcast.net
