During swim meets, Ocean Pines allows diving race-starts at the starting end. The facility also provides large rest rooms with showers. The pool is located on the eastern-most end of Sea Breeze Road in North Ocean Pines.

From the West: Route 50 East to Route 90 East. Exit Route 90 at Route 589 (Racetrack Rd) exit. From Ramp, turn left onto 589 north. Turn right at the second traffic light onto Ocean Parkway at the North Ocean Pines entrance. Continue on the Parkway for 1.9 miles. Turn left onto Sea Breeze Road (third street after White Horse Park). Pool facility is at the end of the road.

From the North: 113 South. Six miles from Selbyville, DE, exit onto Route 589 (Ocean Pines). Take a left onto 589 South (Racetrack Rd). Turn left (at second traffic light) onto Ocean Parkway at the North Ocean Pines entrance. Continue on the Parkway for 1.9 miles. Turn left onto Sea Breeze Road (third street after White Horse Park). Pool facility is at the end of the road.

From the South: 113 North to Route 90 East. Exit Route 90 at Route 589 (Racetrack Rd) exit. From Ramp, turn left onto 589 north. Turn right at the second traffic light onto Ocean Parkway at the North Ocean Pines entrance. Continue on the Parkway for 1.9 miles. Turn left onto Sea Breeze Road (third street after White Horse Park). Pool facility is at the end of the road.
